This year we are fortunate to be visiting the **Kawartha Turtle Trauma Centre** (KTTC). Their website states: "The KTTC is made up of people who all have one goal in mind – helping turtles. Turtles are in big trouble! Seven of the eight species found in Ontario are considered "at risk" – meaning they are at risk of becoming extinct.
